



## Deposit and Tuition

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Tuition varies by camps and classes. Tuition rates are listed within the description of each camp or class.

### Six-Week Summer Classes

A \$20.00 non-refundable deposit is due upon enrollment to hold your child's spot. The session charge listed, once you enroll, is your remaining balance. The balance is due on June 15.

### Summer Camps

A \$25.00 deposit is due upon enrollment to hold your child's spot. The session charge listed, once you enroll, is your remaining balance. The balance is due two weeks prior to the first day of the camp.

### Discounts

Students enrolling in two or more camps or classes will receive a 10% discount off of each camp or class. We have to manually apply the discounts and will do so two weeks prior to each summer camp or class.

### Free Summer Shirt

All students enrolled by May 15 in a Summer 2026 Camp or Class will receive a free t-shirt! Make sure you give us your child's t-shirt size when you enroll. You will see a box to do so when you are completing the Student Information section as you enroll.

## Withdrawal or Transfer

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All transfer and withdrawal requests **MUST** be submitted through the Change Request Form on our website.

Withdrawal or transfer requests received two weeks prior to the first day of camp or class will be issued a full refund, minus a \$25 fee, OR a full credit transfer into another camp or class, based on availability. Refunds will be issued via check within 14 days of the request.

Withdrawals or transfer requests made one week prior to the start of camp or class will be issued a 50% refund OR a full credit transfer into another camp or class, based on availability. Refunds will be issued via check within 14 days of the request.

Withdrawal or transfer requests received less than one week before the start of camp or class will not be issued a refund or a balance transfer to another camp or class.

## Drop-Off and Pick-Up Location

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### Six-Week Summer Classes

Most six-week classes are held on the north side of the building in our dance studios. Acting, Broadway Voice Technique, Musical Theatre Song Study, and rehearsals for *The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee* are held at the Loft Theatre, our black box theater space, located on the east side of our building to the left of Hey Pickle Pickle.

### Summer Camps

Most summer camps will start and end their day in our dance studios. If the camp uses the Loft Theatre, our black box theater space, campers will walk together with the instructors to that part of the building. If the camp starts or ends at the Loft Theatre, we will let you know in advance.

## Drop-Off and Pick-Up Times

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### Six-Week Summer Classes

Please arrive on time to your class. We ask that you arrive no earlier than five minutes before your child's class time, to help with traffic flow. Please pick your child up on time. Our instructors have other classes to teach and need to keep all classes on schedule.

### Summer Camps

All-day summer camps that meet from 9:00 am-4:00 pm (except *The Addams Family*) have the option of dropping their child off between 8:30-9:00 am and picking them up from 4:00-4:30 pm. Please arrive within those times.

All other camp drop-off and pick-up times are the start and end time of the camp. Please do not arrive any earlier than five minutes before their camp starts and please pick them up on time.

## Class Viewing

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Parents and siblings are asked to wait in our lobby during classes. You can view classes through our viewing windows or monitors. You are welcome to bring your laptop and take advantage of the wireless internet connection at our facility. However, you do not need to feel obligated to stay during your child's class. Please feel free to leave and run errands or have some nice quiet time to yourself! **During camps, we ask that parents do not stay, as we use our lobby for snacks and other activities.**

## Dress Code

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Students attending camps can come in clothes that allow for ease of movement. Children wearing dresses should wear shorts under their dress. If they have dance shoes (and are enrolled in a Dance, Production, or Showstoppers camp), they are welcome and encouraged to bring them. We do not require dance shoes or dance attire for our summer camps.

Students enrolled in six-week dance classes in the summer do need to follow our dress code, which can be viewed on our website.

## Camp Specific Details

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### What to Bring

#### Half-Day Camps

Students in dance camps will be provided with a snack. Students in all other half-day camps should bring one snack and a bottle of water.

#### All-Day Camps

Students need to bring two snacks, a bottle of water, and a lunch. Please make sure their lunch bag/box is labeled. Please refrain from sending any food items that contain peanuts or tree nuts, as there are individuals who have severe allergic reactions to them.

### What NOT to Bring

Students should leave their phone, tablet, and other electronics at home. If you feel they must have their phone for emergency purposes, they must leave it in their bag. If they are continually distracted by their phone during camp, the teacher will have to take it away and hold onto it until the end of the day.

### Bathroom

All campers must be able to use the bathroom independently, as our staff is not permitted to enter the bathroom while a child is using it.

### Daily Activities

Each day students will participate in educational activities that go along with the theme for the camp. Activities vary by camp, but are intended to further each camper's arts education in a fun, engaging way.

## End of Camp Performances

At the end of most camps, there is a short, informal performance for parents. One-day camps and scenic painting camps do not have an end of camp performance.

During the end of camp performance, students will share with their parents what they learned at camp that week. Dance camps will present several short dances in multiple dance styles. Acting Adventure camps present a short play. Showstoppers camps present a short musical or musical revue. The performances take place in our dance studios. Camps with larger enrollments may have two performances and the parents will be split into two audiences, in order to make room for everyone.

Production camps have ticketed performances and not end of camp presentations. See the next section for details.

If your child is enrolled in a production this summer, you will need to purchase tickets to attend their show. Tickets will go on sale the week of the show. The following are ticketed productions:
